The Vanguard Way (VGW) Companion is intended to help you plan your itinerary, by providing details of public transport and a guide to facilities such as accommodation, opportunities for refreshment, toilets, phone boxes, post offices, shops selling food and outdoor equipment, places of entertainment, police stations and hospitals though in an emergency you should of course dial 112 or 999 – see page 27).

The information provided in this guide was correct at the time of publication but is subject to change or deletion at any time. We would be grateful to hear from you if you find any changes or additions – please email *colin@vanguardway.org.uk*.

If you find problems along the route, such as obstructions, crops growing on public rights of way, broken stiles etc., we provide contact details for the relevant highway authorities as indicated in the introductions to the route description. In such cases please remember to let us know too by emailing *colin@vanguardway.org.uk*.

A list of local tourist information centres is provided in case you need further information about places or attractions in the area.

Finally, that all-important subject for walkers - the weather. We suggest how you can obtain a forecast for the area.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Trains and trams. We provide below basic information for train and tram services along the Vanguard Way – they operate daily unless shown otherwise.

Buses. In the route descriptions and in the list below, we show places where bus services should be available. However, as they and the days of operation change so much, except in special circumstances we no longer provide further details. The best way to find details of bus services in advance is online, either through Transport for London's Journey Planner for Sections 1 (north-south) or K (south-north), or Traveline for all other sections. With a smartphone supplied with the appropriate app, it should be possible to get times of buses due at a near-by bus stop, though in many cases they are very infrequent or don't run every day. Contact details are provided below.

TfL and National Rail Enquiries are available 24/7 (all day every day). Traveline telephone service operates 07:00 to 22:00 daily.

The UK Bus Checker app for smartphones provides details of buses due both inside and outside London. In London, you can get a text message giving details of the next three buses at a stop by texting the five-digit stop number (on a plate on all TfL stops) to 87287. Alternatively, consult *m.tfl.gov.uk* from a smartphone. Outside London, text the stop code (displayed on the bus stop flag or timetable) to 84268. Alternatively, consult *www.nextbuses.mobi* from a smartphone.

There are also many smartphone apps giving train and bus information. For train information, we suggest using the National Rail app. For all transport modes in London, we suggest using the Citymapper app; outside London use the Traveline South & East app.

Maps of tube and rail services in London and the south east of England are available at: www.nationalrail.co.uk/stations_destinations/maps.aspx.

TfL and the county councils also publish details of bus services including maps online and are worth consulting, before you travel.

TAXIS AND MINICABS

In many places, you may need or prefer to travel to or from the VGW by taxi or minicab. It's easy to book one in advance online, using either Apple, Bing or Google Maps: in the search box, just enter 'taxis' followed by the required location and a list of those nearby should appear on the left, with their locations shown on the map, then choose one and call them. Searchable maps are also available as an app for mobile phones from Apple (https://www.apple.com/uk/ios/maps) or Google (https://www.google.co.uk/intl/en_uk/mobile/maps)

For more options visit www.yell.com or www.traintaxi.co.uk to find numbers for taxis near a rail station.

In Greater London, TfL's 'Find a local minicab' web page can be used online or from smartphones.

Fares vary but should be in the region of £5-6 per mile (£7-8 per mile in Greater London) - this may seem a lot, but bear in mind that you also have to cover the taxi's return journey. In theory, calling the nearest operator should be cheaper and bring a car most quickly to your location.

FACILITIES GUIDE

The following information is a guide to facilities that may be useful to Vanguard Wayfarers, where we know they exist, particularly accommodation and refreshments. **Information is subject to change and you are strongly advised to check beforehand that any facilities you may require are available** - phone numbers and websites are given where known. Email addresses can usually be obtained from websites where available.

For places with a wide selection of establishments, such as Croydon, East Grinstead and Seaford, we have necessarily had to be selective, generally choosing those that are most convenient to the route or station links. It is impractical to include all the information we would like about facilities along the route, so we just provide basic details.

Places some distance off route that have the nearest available emergency facilities - such as police stations, hospitals, etc. - or tourist information centres are also shown.

Inclusion in this list in no way constitutes a recommendation, and we cannot accept responsibility for any shortcomings, but we shall be pleased to hear your opinions of places you have used along the route. We would also be most grateful if you could pass on to us details of any changes to the information shown, of establishments not included here, or of any shown that are no longer available. How to use the facilities guide

Locations are listed in order from north to south. Within each location, accommodation facilities are shown first, in ascending order of price range, then refreshment facilities, then other facilities such as

toilets, phone boxes, tourist information centres and shops.

(VGW) indicates a position beside or very close to the route.

> indicates places that are at least 1 km off route.

Figures in brackets indicate approximate distance in kilometres off-route.

TQ or TV followed by a six-figure number indicates the grid reference for location of accommodation and refreshments, where known.

The following symbols are used:

Telephone number.

Website address (URL = uniform resource locator), shown in italics. The full address usually includes either 'http://' or 'https://' but these should be automatically inserted when you type the address in the address box.

Email addresses. We do not normally show these as they can change so much, but you should be able to either find them on the website or use the email contact form that is provided on many websites.

The **Facilities Line Diagram** on the following pages should help you work out at a glance where to find public transport, accommodation and refreshments, and how far between them. Then refer to the list to find details of what is available.

ACCOMMODATION

Establishments providing accommodation up to around 3 km off-route have been included to provide a wider choice, sometimes a little further where accommodation is in short supply.

Establishments that are some distance off route may be willing to provide transport from and back to the route.

If you prefer to 'walk light', with just the items you need for the day, you could consider sending your main baggage ahead by taxi (see 6), or some accommodation establishments may be willing to do this for a fee.

The type of accommodation is indicated by the following letters:

C Camping facilities

G Guest house, or B+B (bed and breakfast)

H Hotel or inn

SC Self-catering (we only show these where bookings are accepted for 1 or 2 nights)

Y Youth hostel

Generally, hotels and inns are licensed to sell alcohol but guest houses and B+Bs are not, though there are exceptions.

Actual prices are not shown since they can fluctuate considerably. As a guide, our 'x' system indicates the approximate price range for bed and breakfast, per person per night sharing a double- or twin-bedded room as at Autumn 2018. Supplements may be charged for single rooms, en suite bathrooms, etc.

You may be able to obtain lower prices by booking online through one of the hotel booking agencies - do a search for the hotel or B+B you require, or just the location + 'hotels' or 'bed and breakfast', and see what comes up.

Within reasonable distance of the VGW (though you may need a taxi to reach some of them) there are currently four Premier Inns (at Coombe near Croydon, Clacket Lane on the M25, East Grinstead and Denton near Newhaven) and five Travelodges (at Croydon, South Croydon, Whyteleafe, East Grinstead, Tunbridge Wells and Lower Dicker), where much lower rates may be available by paying in advance, though they are usually non-refundable.

SELF-CATERING. There is a small number of self-catering establishments along the route (marked **SC**) which accept bookings for one or two nights, so may be suitable for VGW walkers.

HOSTELLING. Although the VGW was designed back in 1980 to link the four YHA hostels then open near the route, ironically all have since closed, so as far as we know there is now no hostel-type accommodation available close to the route. However, Beachy Head Youth Hostel near Eastbourne is just a 15-minute bus ride from Exceat.

CAMPING. There are very few official campsites located close to the VGW, and we know of none anywhere near the northern part of the route. Further south, mostly in East Sussex, we know of official sites close to the VGW at Blackboys, Golden Cross, Exceat and Bishopstone, and some way off route at or near Lingfield, Hartfield, Horam and Halland. Details are shown in the facilities list. Otherwise, with the permission of the landowner, you may be able to camp on farmland or in some pub gardens, including the Berwick Inn at Berwick Station.

Note that no camping is permitted within the Ashdown Forest.

MEALS & REFRESHMENTS

As a rule, refreshment facilities in our list are within about 1 km of the route. There is however one particularly long 'barren' stretch of $18\frac{1}{2}$ km ($11\frac{1}{2}$ miles) - between Crockham Hill and Forest Row with no refreshments closer than $1\frac{1}{2}$ km, so you will need to carry your own supplies on this stretch.

Hotels and inns (marked 'H') usually provide meals and refreshments to non-residents. Additional establishments are shown thus:

- Public house.
- Restaurant, cafe or tea-room.

For the many walkers who like to patronise J.D.Wetherspoon's establishments, they are located at Croydon, Selsdon, Oxted, East Grinstead, Crowborough, Tunbridge Wells and Eastbourne.
